# SOCIALISM IS THE FUTURE, BUILD IT NOW!

The SACP Che Guevara Branch was launched on 27 June 2015. It services and functions within ward 25 of the Sol Plaatjie Local Municipality, more specifically the Du Toitspan Voting District, comprising of Beaconsfield, Herlear, Greenside, Cassandra and Elektra Park.

The branch has been raising funds for Mandela Day and these funds were used to procure vegetables and meat. The branch decided on a food security and nutrition programme to be in line with the theme for Mandela Day 2015: "Food security, Education and Literacy, Shelter and Infrastructure, Service and Volunteerism." Other areas in the theme also addressed were education and volunteerism.

Branch members volunteered to transport and packaged the vegetable and meat packs. Families were identified making use of data that was collected in the continuous SACP Programme "Know and act in your neighbourhood Campaign." The programme brought vegetables to the homes of 50 needy families in the area serviced by the branch, and ensured joy and nutrition on a day where Madiba's legacy might so easy have been forgotten due to hunger and hopelessness
